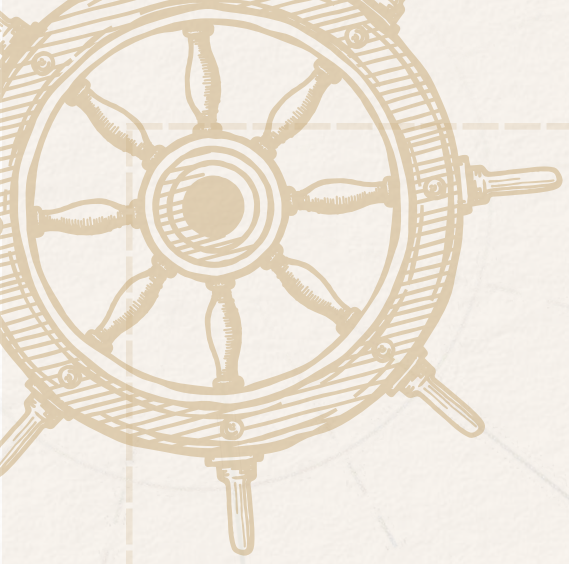

Where Ancient Creatures Meet Pristine Oceans

The Komodo National Park is a UNESCO World Heritage site that consists of 3 larger islands Komodo, Rinca, and Padar, and over 20 smaller ones, many of which are uninhabited. Komodo and Rinca are home to the legendary Komodo dragons, respected by locals who believe they descend from one born to a dragon princess centuries ago. The mystical hidden paradise of Komodo National Park and surrounding islands will enthrall travelers with its wild adventure. A remote land ruled by dragons where active volcanos rise from the ocean gives way to its unique treasures

Initially founded in 1980 to protect its remarkable inhabitant, the Komodo dragon, the National Park has since been extended the protection to include additional terrestrial inhabits on the islands and the biodiverse marine life.

Getting There

Anne Bonny moors at the closest harbor to the airport and transfers are provided by private vehicle directly to our waiting tenders. All airports are serviced by scheduled airlines, while selected airports can accommodate private jets.

DAY 01

Labuan Bajo and Sebayur

Embark from Labuan Bajo at 10:00 AM and settle in after a welcome and safety briefing. Anne Bonny cruises toward Sebayur, a calm and sheltered area ideal for the first day. Guests can enjoy snorkeling, kayaking, or a relaxed walk along the beach at sunset. Wakeboarding is available in calm bays, with an optional night dive for certified divers.

Dive Sites: (1–2 dives)

- Sebayur Kecil – Gentle sloping reef, rich in reef fish and macro life
- Optional Night Dive – Cuttlefish, crustaceans, and bioluminescence



DAY 02

Manta Point & Gili Lawa Darat

Today focuses on Komodo's northern waters, known for stronger currents and higher marine activity. Snorkel or dive at Manta Point, where manta rays are frequently encountered, followed by drift activities around Tatawa. In the late afternoon, hike Gili Lawa Darat for panoramic views of the archipelago. The day concludes with a traditional sail-raising ceremony at sunset.

Dive Sites: (Possible 3 dives)

- Tatawa Besar – Drift dive with anthias, sweetlips, and healthy coral
- Manta Point – Reef mantas and pelagic sightings (seasonal)
- Gili Lawa Wall / Passage – Coral walls, turtles, possible reef sharks





DAY 03

Komodo Island & Pink Beach

Begin the day with a guided trek on Komodo Island to observe Komodo dragons in their natural environment. After lunch, anchor at Pink Beach for swimming and relaxation. The afternoon is spent in the calm waters of Siaba Besar, suitable for both snorkeling and easy dives. The day ends with a BBQ dinner on board, shared with your private group.

Dive Sites:

- Siaba Besar – Seagrass meadows, turtles, and coral gardens
- Pink Beach Reef – Soft coral slope with good visibility



DAY 04

Return to Labuan Bajo

Enjoy a final morning on board as Anne Bonny sails back to Labuan Bajo. No planned activities. Disembark between 09:00–10:00 AM, with transfers available to the airport or local hotels.
