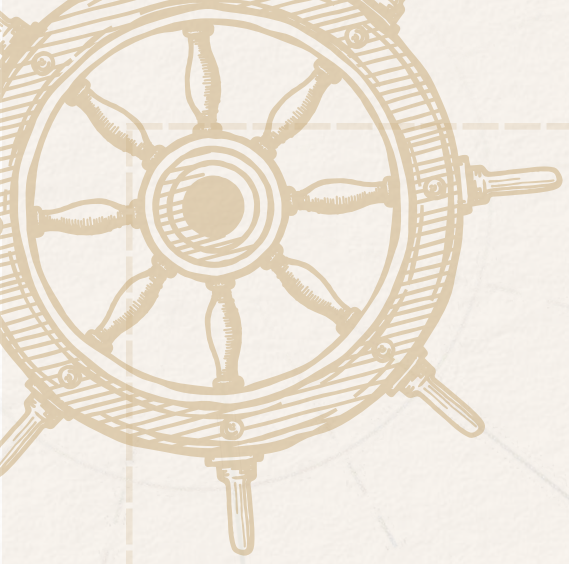

The Komodo National Park is a UNESCO World Heritage site that consists of 3 larger islands Komodo, Rinca, and Padar, and over 20 smaller ones, many of which are uninhabited. Komodo and Rinca are home to the legendary Komodo dragons, respected by locals who believe they descend from one born to a dragon princess centuries ago. The mystical hidden paradise of Komodo National Park and surrounding islands will enthrall travelers with its wild adventure. A remote land ruled by dragons where active volcanos rise from the ocean gives way to its unique treasures

Initially founded in 1980 to protect its remarkable inhabitant, the Komodo dragon, the National Park has since been extended the protection to include additional terrestrial inhabits on the islands and the biodiverse marine life.

DAY 01

Embarkation and Sebayur

Board in Labuan Bajo and cruise toward Sebayur Island. Enjoy snorkeling at Kanawa Island, kayaking in Sebayur's sheltered bays, and a sunset beach walk with panoramic views.

Dive Sites: (2 dives)

- Sebayur Besar – Gentle reef slope ideal for check dives
- Sebayur Kecil – Coral bommies and macro life in shallow waters



DAY 02

Tatawa / Gili Lawa Darat

Enjoy snorkeling along Tatawa Besar's colorful coral highways and drift-snorkeling through the Golden Passage with turtles and jacks. The area also offers a scenic trek to the viewpoint at Gili Lawa Darat, perfect for capturing stunning sunset photos.

Dive Sites: (2 dives)

- Tatawa Besar – Drift dive with colorful corals and reef fish
- Golden Passage – Strong currents with pelagics and vibrant coral walls





DAY 03

Pink Beach / Sabita Bay

Enjoy the soft sands of Pink Beach and explore Sabita's wilderness for a Komodo dragon encounter. The area offers vibrant snorkeling in the high-energy Shotgun channel, with chances to see manta rays and schooling fish. End the day with a sunset sail-opening ceremony and a photo session in the bay.

Dive Sites: (2 dives)

- Shotgun – Fast drift with pelagics and coral bommies
- Sabita Reef – Calm site with reef fish and coral heads



DAY 04

Karang Makassar / Kelor

Explore Kelor Island's beach and hike to a scenic viewpoint for sunset photography. The area offers snorkeling with manta rays at Karang Makassar, wakeboarding in calm waters, and coral-garden snorkeling around Tengah, providing a mix of wildlife encounters and relaxed coastal activities.

Dive Sites: (2 dives)

- Karang Makassar – Drift dive with regular manta ray encounters
- Tengah – Coral reef with great visibility and diverse marine life

DAY
05

Padar Island Adventure

Explore Padar's dramatic landscape with a ridgeline hike and photo opportunities overlooking its iconic bays. The island offers kayaking through sheltered coves and snorkeling along a reef-rich coastline, combining scenic viewpoints with relaxed water activities.

Dive Sites: (2 dives)

- Three Sisters – Pinnacles with coral and fish life
- W Reef – Shallow reef ideal for relaxed diving with turtles



DAY
06

Desa Rinca / Pulau Seraya

Visit Desa Rinca to meet the local community, then enjoy clear-water snorkeling around Pulau Anita, known for clownfish and vibrant coral gardens. The day ends with a relaxed sunset BBQ on Pulau Seraya's beach, offering a quiet coastal atmosphere.

Dive Sites: (2 dives)

- Pulau Anita North Wall – Coral slope with macro highlights such as pygmy seahorses

07

Return to Labuan Bajo

Enjoy a peaceful morning on board as Anne Bonny sails back toward Labuan Bajo. Guests can relax on deck and take in the final views of Komodo's volcanic islands.
