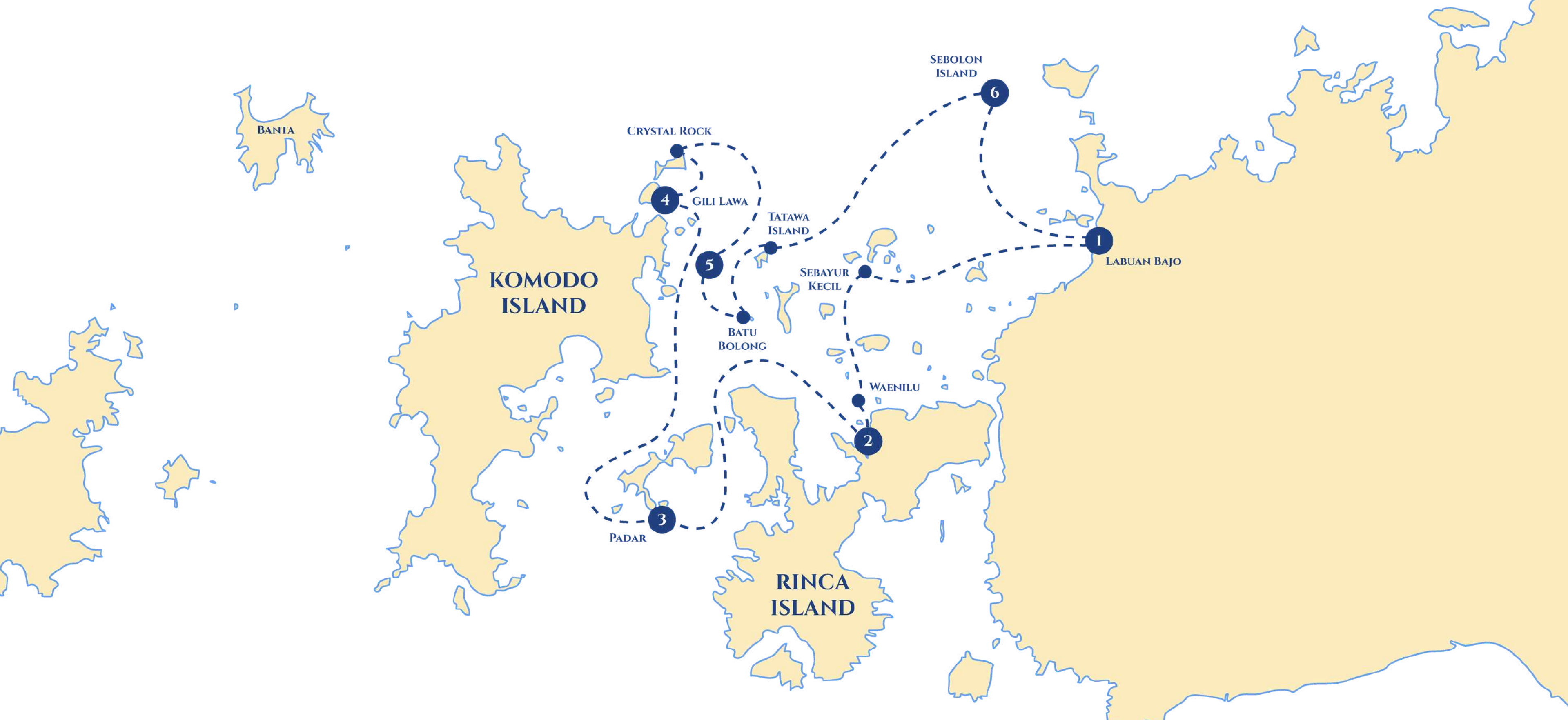

DAY 01

PULAU SEBAYUR & PULAU WAENILU

Overview

Upon arrival at Labuan Bajo airport, you'll be picked up and transferred to Jakare, waiting for you at the nearby port. Once on board, your journey begins with a sail to Pulau Sebayur Kecil, where you can enjoy a relaxed afternoon on the beach or in the water—snorkeling or diving. Later, you'll continue toward the peaceful mangroves of Pulau Waenilu, where the boat will anchor for the night.

Activities

You'll be welcomed on board with refreshing drinks and light snacks. Your Cruise Director will introduce the crew, provide a safety briefing, and walk you through how life on board works as well as what to expect from the cruise ahead.

Once you're settled into your cabin, take some time to refresh and prepare for the first leg of your journey. As Jakare sails toward Pulau Sebayur, you can enjoy the calm and get familiar with the itinerary and the surroundings.

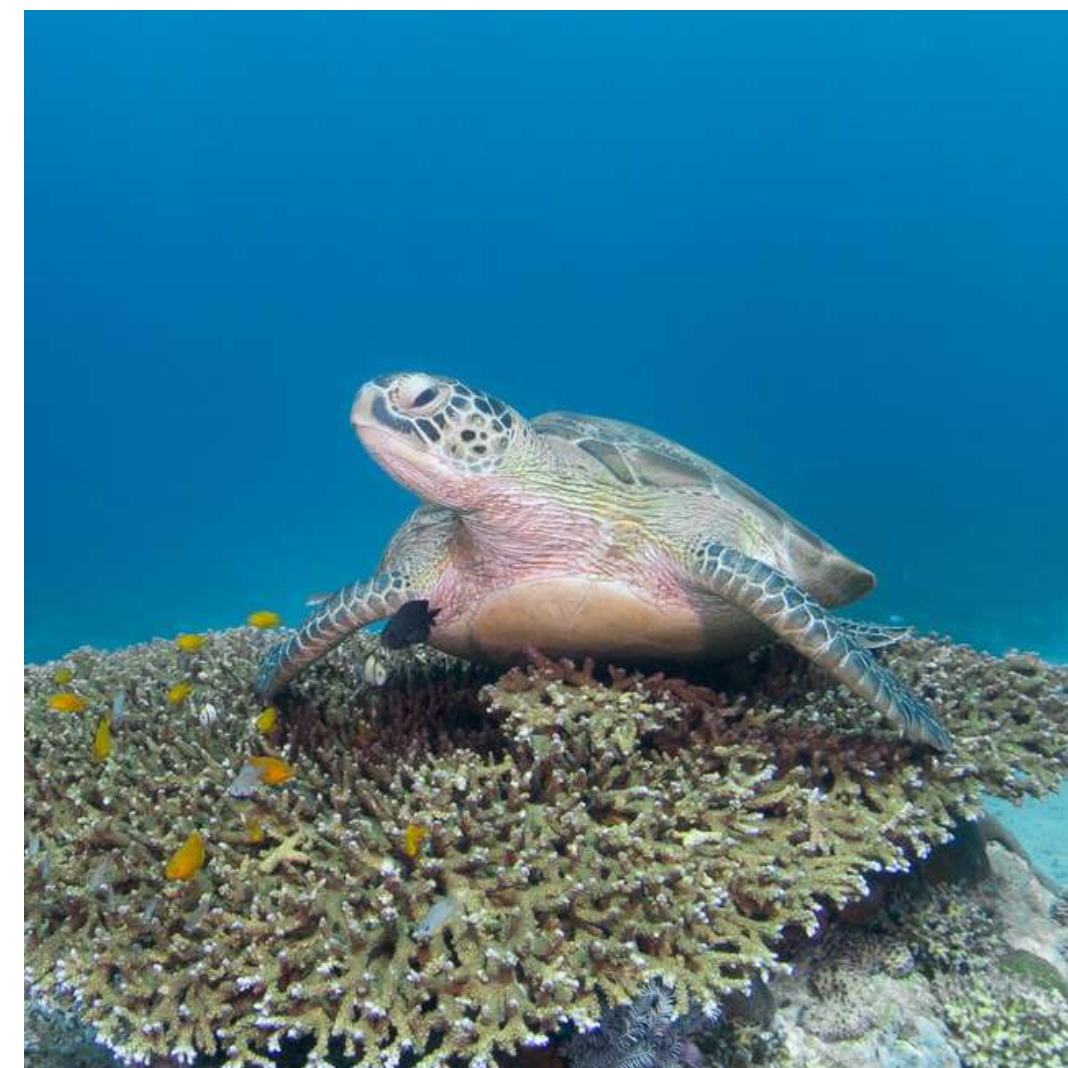
Once at Sebayur, you'll have your first chance to snorkel in vibrant coral gardens. If time permits, you may also explore nearby beaches by kayak or stand-up paddleboard and try out the equipment.

Later in the day, Jakare will head south toward Pulau Kambing or Waenilu and anchor near the small islands. If time allows, there may be a stop to visit Rinca Village or to witness the incredible sunset flight of bats at Pulau Kaaba.

Diver Option

- Enjoy a gentle check dive at Sebayur Kecil to test your equipment, refresh your skills, and get comfortable with the dive setup.

Dive at Waenilu, a fantastic site for macro photography and spotting unique underwater life





DAY 02

KOMODO DRAGON AND PULAU PADAR

Overview

Start your day early with a visit to see Komodo Dragons at Loh Buaya on Rinca Island. Then, sail to Pulau Padar for a full afternoon of snorkeling, diving, or beach trekking. You'll anchor overnight in the scenic bay of Padar.

Activities

At dawn, take a dinghy to the shore at Loh Buaya. You'll be greeted by local rangers, who will guide you to the park office for a short briefing. From there, set out on a guided walk through the island—lasting anywhere from 30 minutes to two hours depending on the trail you choose. You're likely to see Komodo dragons, as well as wild boars, deer, and tropical birds.

After your walk, return to Jakare for a refreshing swim around the boat followed by a well-earned breakfast. You'll then set sail for Pulau Padar, with the chance to stop at Pulau Tengah or the southern part of Siaba Besar for a dive or snorkel. Upon arrival in Padar, enjoy beach time, paddle the coast by kayak or SUP, or simply relax with the stunning views.

Diver Option

- Dive at Pulau Tengah (advanced only), a dynamic pinnacle rich with marine life such as turtles, jacks, and sharks.
- Explore Three Sisters for its rich diversity of nudibranchs, critters, and schooling fusiliers.
- Other great options include Secret Garden in Padar Bay and Police Corner near Siaba Besar.

DAY 03

PULAU PADAR AND KOMODO CENTRAL

Overview

Begin with an early morning hike for sunrise on Pulau Padar, followed by breakfast and water activities. Later, head north toward Komodo Central. Afterward, enjoy more exploration before anchoring in North Komodo for the night.

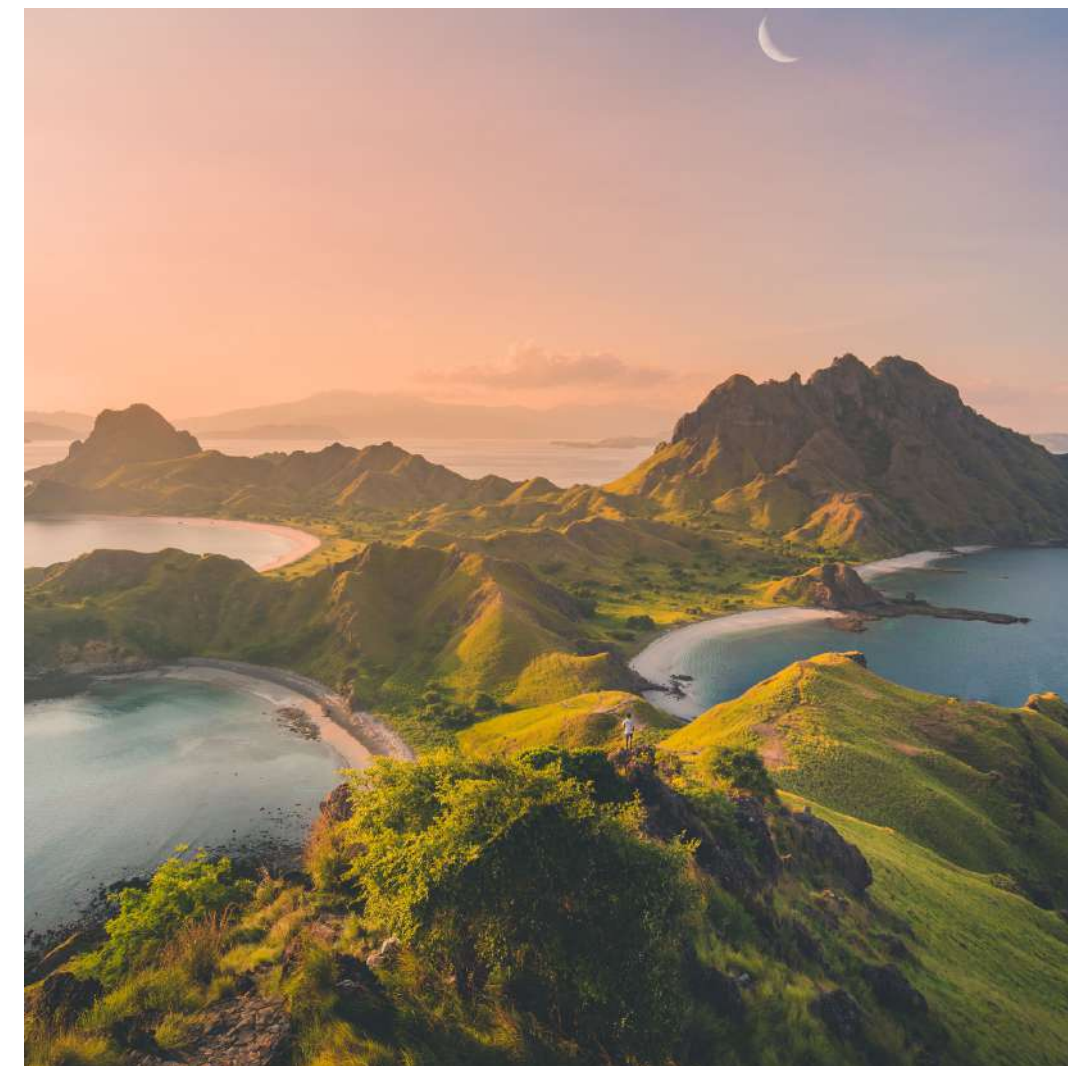
Activities

Climb to Padar's viewpoint for a spectacular sunrise. After the hike, cool off with a swim and enjoy a rich breakfast on board. If the conditions are right, you can dive or snorkel before Jakare continues north.

Then, explore the waters and landscapes around Central Komodo, including sandbanks, mangroves, and small islands. Later, anchor in the peaceful Gili Lawa Barat for the night.

Diver Option

- Pilarsteen: a colorful wall dive with caves and swim-throughs, home to schools of fusiliers and coral fish.
- Siaba Kecil: a beautiful drift dive for advanced divers, featuring hard coral, sea fans, and pelagic activity in the blue.





DAY

04

NORTH KOMODO, GILI LAWА

Overview

Spend the day immersed in the beauty of Gili Lawa—diving, trekking, snorkeling, relaxing on the beach, or paddling along the coast by kayak or stand-up paddleboard. You’ll anchor and spend the night in this peaceful northern part of Komodo National Park.

Activities

Begin your morning with an early wake-up and a climb to the main viewpoint of Gili Lawa. From the top, you’ll enjoy a breathtaking sunrise across the Komodo archipelago.

After the hike, prepare for a dive or snorkel at Golden Passage. This area, situated between Gili Lawa Darat and Komodo Island, is known for its healthy soft and hard coral reefs and an abundance of marine life. Expect encounters with turtles and, if you're lucky, larger pelagic predators passing through the currents.

Later, Jakare will reposition to the northern side of Gili Lawa—Gili Lawa Laut—where more opportunities await for snorkeling, diving, or relaxing on the beach.

Crystal Rock is next on the list. Famous for its incredibly clear water, this exposed pinnacle faces the open current and attracts a high concentration of marine life. Here, you might see reef sharks, grey sharks, giant trevally, and vibrant reef fish. The site is suitable for all diving levels and also ideal for snorkeling, especially around the gentler coral slopes where smaller marine creatures hide.



If conditions allow, a dive or snorkel at The Cauldron will be proposed. This iconic site is a channel between Gili Lawa Darat and Gili Lawa Laut. It offers dramatic underwater landscapes and a thrilling current that brings in manta rays, eagle rays, and pelagic fish such as trevally and tuna. The hard coral gardens on either side are stunning, and with luck, you might also spot critters like frogfish and nudibranchs.

Toward the end of the day, Jakare will move to a quiet anchorage on the eastern shore of Gili Lawa. This is your time to unwind, explore the surrounding area, or paddle over the nearby reefs using the kayak or SUP. Anchoring and overnight at Gili Lawa.

Diver Options:

- Golden Passage
- Crystal Rock
- Castle Rock

DAY 05

CENTRAL KOMODO, MANTA POINT AND BATU BOLONG

Overview

A day of iconic underwater encounters awaits. You'll snorkel or dive at sites famous for manta rays, vibrant reefs, and thrilling currents—including Karang Makassar, Batu Bolong, and Tatawa—before setting sail to Pulau Sabolan.

Activities

Begin your day with a visit to Karang Makassar, accessed by dinghy. This expansive reef lies in shallow waters (8–15 meters) and is known for manta ray encounters. These graceful creatures glide through the currents to get cleaned by small reef fish—a captivating sight whether you're snorkeling or diving.

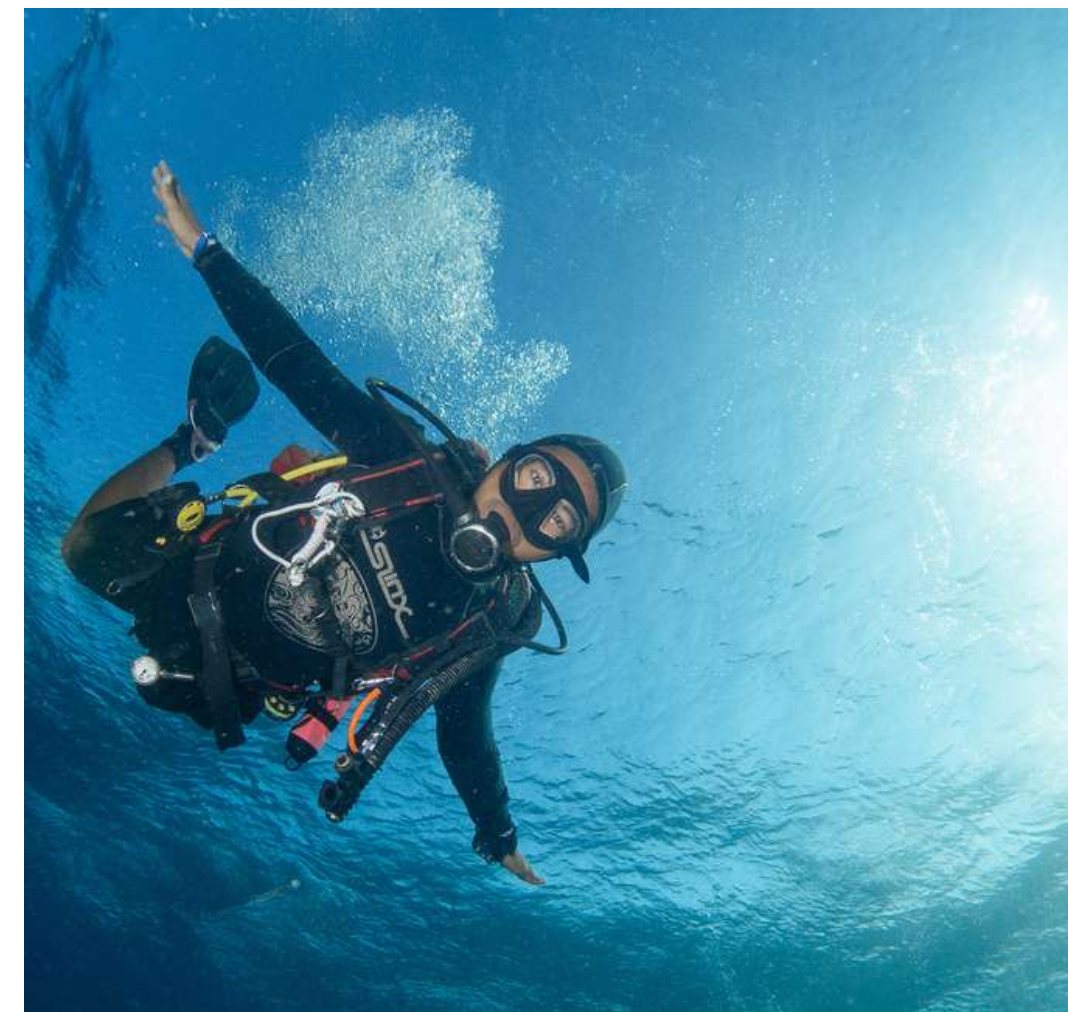
After your manta moment, continue to one of Komodo's most legendary dive sites: Batu Bolong. This isolated pinnacle in the middle of a current-swept channel is alive with color and marine activity. The reef is thriving with both soft and hard corals. Watch the full food chain in motion—from clouds of reef fish to pelagic hunters such as blacktip and whitetip sharks, giant trevally, barracudas, and dogtooth tuna. This site is dynamic and unforgettable.

Depending on sea conditions, you'll then move to Pulau Tatawa for a relaxed snorkeling or diving session. The coral gardens here are healthy and vibrant, and the current often brings in large schools of fish. Turtles are commonly seen gliding across the reef.

In the late afternoon, Jakare will set course for Pulau Sabolan, where you'll anchor for the night.

Diver Options:

- Karang Makassar or Mawan for manta encounters
- Batu Bolong for an adrenaline-filled dive with stunning biodiversity
- Tatawa Besar or Tatawa Kecil for advanced divers seeking strong current and rich marine life





DAY

06

PULAU SABOLAN AND RETURN TO LABUAN BAJO

Overview

Spend your final morning enjoying water activities around Pulau Sabolan before returning to Labuan Bajo.

Activities

Enjoy snorkeling or paddling in the clear waters of Sabolan. This final activity session is a perfect way to end your journey.

Afterward, Jakare will begin her return sail to Labuan Bajo.

You'll have time to exchange photos and say goodbye to fellow travelers and crew. A small farewell ceremony will be held before your transfer to the airport or your hotel, no later than 12 PM.
