Deserted Islands, Dragons & Manta Rays

The Komodo National Park is a UNESCO World Heritage site that consists of 3 larger islands Komodo, Rinca, and Padar, and over 20 smaller ones, many of which are uninhabited. Komodo and Rinca are home to the legendary Komodo dragons, respected by locals who believe they descend from one born to a dragon princess centuries ago. The mystical hidden paradise of Komodo National Park and surrounding islands will enthrall travelers with its wild adventure. A remote land ruled by dragons where active volcanos rise from the ocean gives way to its unique treasures.

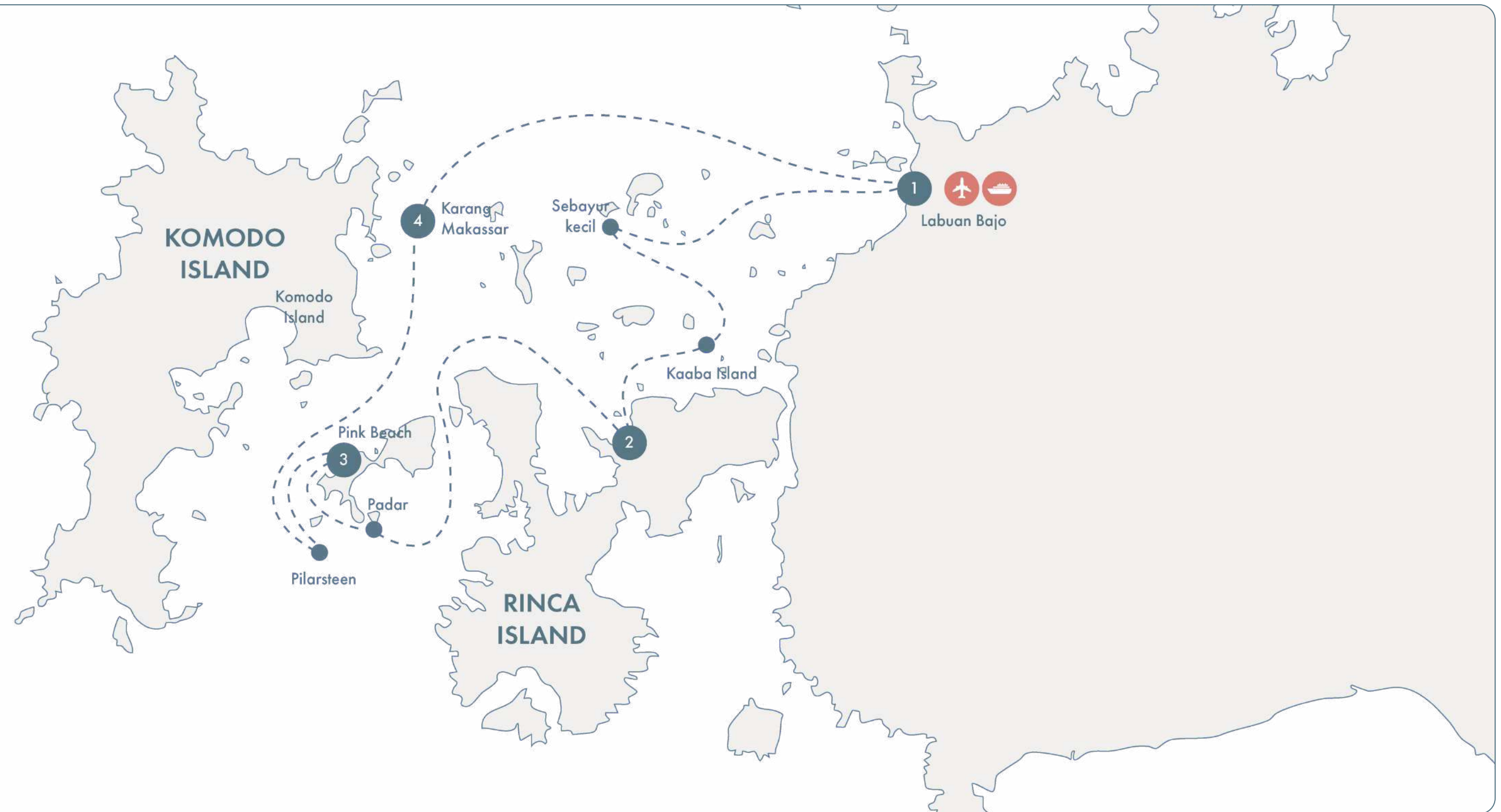
Initially founded in 1980 to protect its remarkable inhabitant, the Komodo dragon, the National Park has since been extended the protection to include additional terrestrial inhabits on the islands and the biodiverse marine life.

Getting There

Jinggo Janggo moors at the closest harbor to the airport and transfers are provided by private vehicle directly to our waiting tenders.

All airports are serviced by scheduled airlines, while selected airports can accommodate private jets.

○ Sebayur Besar/ Sebayur Kecil

Arrival at Labuan Bajo airport or hotel in the morning. Transfer to the boat and welcome drinks on board. Introduction of the crew, safety briefing, and overview of the itinerary. Navigation (10NM) to Pulau Sebayur Kecil for snorkeling in the coral garden, kayaking, or stand-up paddleboarding along the pristine beaches.

After lunch, sailing (10NM) to Pulau Kaaba, with the option to visit Rinca Village or enjoy a swim around the boat. At sunset, bat-watching experience as thousands of bats take flight. Relax on the sundeck and enjoy the starlit sky.

Diver option: Refresh dive at **SEBAYUR KECIL** to test equipment and refresh dive skills.

○ Komodo Dragon at Pulau Rinca and Pulau Padar

Early morning sail to Pulau Kambing, arriving around 7:30 AM. Transfer by dinghy to Loh Buaya, where rangers will guide a trek through Rinca's savannah (30 min to 2 hours), offering chances to see Komodo dragons, wild boars, and deer.

Return to Jinggo Janggo for a refreshing swim before breakfast, then sail to Pulau Padar (12NM). Afternoon activities include snorkeling, beach discovery, or a kayak/SUP ride along the untouched coastline.

For the most active, a sunset trek to Padar's famous viewpoint will be organized before dinner onboard. Overnight anchorage at Pulau Padar.

Diver Option:

- **PULAU TENGAH (Advanced only):** A dynamic pinnacle dive in strong currents, featuring vibrant coral walls, schools of fish, turtles, sharks, and pelagic species.
- **THREE SISTERS:** Three submerged rocks (3-30m depth), known for macro life, schools of fusiliers, and occasional pelagic sightings.

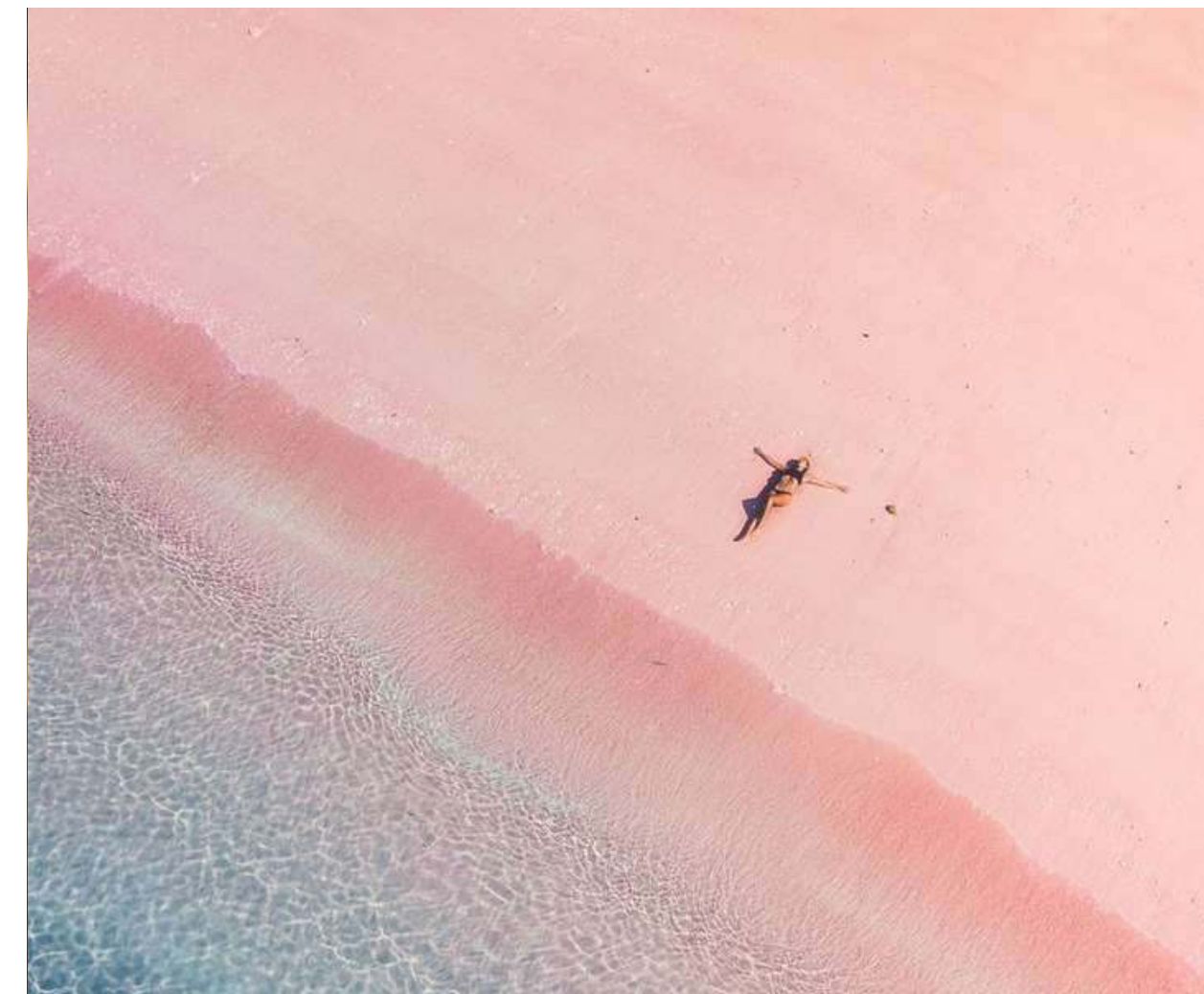
Pink Beach Komodo Central

Sunrise trek to Padar's summit, then return for breakfast and a refreshing swim. Sail to Pink Beach for snorkeling and relaxation.

After lunch, navigation to Pulau Sabita. Afternoon exploration of nearby sandbanks, islands, or mangroves. Sunset on a secluded sandbank before dinner onboard. Overnight at Pulau Sabita.

Diver Option:

- **PILLARSTEEN:** Wall dive with colorful corals, caves, and schools of fusiliers.
- **PANTAI MERAH:** Easy dive with rich coral and diverse marine life.

04

Komodo Central & Back to Labuan Bajo

Morning dinghy trip to Karang Makassar, a prime snorkeling site where manta rays and eagle rays can be spotted. A unique spectacle in shallow waters (8-15m).

After lunch, sail to Pulau Sabita for optional snorkeling among vibrant corals and marine life, including turtles.

Afternoon navigation back to Labuan Bajo. Time to relax, review trip memories, and enjoy a farewell ceremony with the crew before transfer to the airport or hotel.
