This beautiful destination is one of Indonesia's most biodiverse regions, part of the Coral Triangle, the global heart of marine life. Here, you'll find calm bays perfect for paddleboarding, reefs filled with turtles and rainbow-colored fish, and the chance to meet the gentle manta rays that gather year-round in these waters.

On land, Komodo is just as special. It's the only place on earth where the iconic Komodo dragon lives in the wild. You can also explore pink-sand beaches, stroll along quiet coastline trails, and climb to incredible viewpoints that make every effort worthwhile. This journey blends adventure with easygoing island days, a beautiful balance of exploring, relaxing, and letting nature surprise you.

Day 01

ARRIVAL IN LABUAN BAJO

This journey begins and ends in Labuan Bajo (LBJ), the gateway to Komodo National Park, with daily direct flights from Bali (DPS).

We recommend arriving one day prior to ensure a smooth start and a refreshed beginning to your trip.

Check-in is scheduled between 6 AM and 11 AM. Please arrange your flights and accommodation accordingly.

Day 02

PADAR ISLAND | MANTA POINT

We begin the day with an early hike on Padar Island, a short yet rewarding climb to one of Komodo's most iconic viewpoints. From the top, the three distinct bays unfold in the soft morning light, an unforgettable start to the day.

After breakfast on board, we cruise to Manta Point, where you can snorkel or dive in gentle currents as graceful manta rays glide through the clear, shallow waters.



Day 03

SOUTH WEST KOMODO

Today we head toward the southwest region of Komodo National Park, known for its wilder landscapes, quieter bays, and rich marine life. Depending on conditions, the morning may include snorkeling or diving at sites like Tatawa, Siaba, or Crystal Bay, where healthy corals, turtles, and vibrant fish life make for relaxed and rewarding time in the water.

We end the day anchored in a quiet bay, with time to unwind on deck as the sun sets behind the islands.

Day 04

SEBAYUR ISLAND

Today is dedicated to the calm, turquoise waters of Sebayur Island, one of Komodo's finest spots for both underwater and above-water experiences. In the morning, snorkel or dive over vibrant coral slopes, home to turtles and reef fish, with gentle currents suited for all levels.

Above the water, enjoy kayaking along quiet coastlines, paddle-boarding in glassy conditions, or simply relaxing on deck or on a secluded beach, taking in the surrounding island views.

Day 05

LABUAN BAJO

After one last breakfast onboard, it's time to say goodbye to The Oracle Yacht and our crew. We'll arrange your transfer back to your hotel or the airport.
