Komodo National Park is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, home to over 1,000 species of fish, more than 260 types of coral, and of course, the world's last population of wild Komodo dragons.

This beautiful destination is one of Indonesia's most biodiverse regions, part of the Coral Triangle, the global heart of marine life. Here, you'll find calm bays perfect for paddleboarding, reefs filled with turtles and rainbow colored fish, and the chance to meet the gentle manta rays that gather year-round in these waters.

On land, Komodo is just as special. It's the only place on earth where the iconic Komodo dragon lives in the wild. You can also explore pink-sand beaches, stroll along quiet coastline trails, and climb to incredible viewpoints that make every effort worthwhile. This journey blends adventure with easygoing island days, a beautiful balance of exploring, relaxing, and letting nature surprise you.

Day 01

ARRIVAL IN LABUAN BAJO

This journey begins and ends in Labuan Bajo (LBJ), the gateway to Komodo National Park, with daily direct flights from Bali (DPS).

We recommend arriving one day prior to ensure a smooth start and a refreshed beginning to your trip.

Check-in is scheduled between 6 AM and 11 AM. Please arrange your flights and accommodation accordingly.

Day 02

GILI LAWALAUT

Today we explore Gili Lawa Laut, known for its panoramic views and vibrant marine life. Snorkel or dive among reefs with turtles, reef sharks, and schools of fish.

Later, enjoy kayaking, paddleboarding, or relaxing on the beach before a short hike to a scenic viewpoint overlooking turquoise bays and rugged coastlines.

We end the day with a leisurely cruise and sunset over the islands.



Day 03

PADAR ISLAND

After breakfast, we head to Komodo National Park, exploring renowned sites like Batu Bolong, Taka Makassar, Mawan, and Siaba Besar. Strong currents attract schools of predatory fish, while snorkeling or diving offers encounters with trevally, tuna, barracuda, and manta rays at Taka Makassar.

In the afternoon, enjoy a sunset trek on Padar Island before returning onboard for a relaxing massage and dinner. The bay also offers time for watersports, beach relaxation, or wildlife spotting.

Day 04

RINCA ISLAND

Set out early to search for Komodo dragons with our crew and local rangers, with chances to spot buffalos, monkeys, and other wildlife. After breakfast onboard, enjoy kayaking or paddleboarding in Komodo Bay. Later, visit Pink Beach before continuing to Nusa Kode.

Day 05

SOUTH RINCA

Today we explore South Rinca, known for its dramatic cliffs, forests, and quiet bays. Wildlife is abundant, with monkeys, deer, wild boar, sea eagles, and occasionally Komodo dragons.

Its cooler, nutrient-rich waters offer excellent snorkeling and diving, with soft corals, nudibranchs, turtles, and possible sightings of dolphins, whales, or mobula rays. A remote and peaceful area, ideal for a relaxed afternoon before anchoring overnight.



Day 06

MANTA POINT

After breakfast, sail to Manta Point for snorkeling or diving with graceful manta rays in calm, clear waters. In the afternoon, relax at leisure, swim in turquoise bays, sunbathe on deck, or enjoy the scenic cruise through Komodo's dramatic islands.

Day 07

SEBAYUR ISLAND

This morning we arrive at the Sebayur islands. Located just outside the national park, this area is ideal for various water sports. We can visit a small village that is very welcoming to visitors, relax onboard with a massage from our spa therapist or just chill on a secluded beach and read a book. Of course, snorkeling and diving options are on offer depending on your flight times tomorrow. This evening we can dine al fresco on the beach or under the stars on the top deck of the vessel.

Day 08

LABUAN BAJO

After a final decadent breakfast on deck our crew will assist you in disembarking The Oracle Yacht and transfer you to the airport or your chosen hotel where we will bid you a fond farewell and hope to see you again soon.
