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FROM REEF TO SHORE: A JOURNEY OF EXPERIENCES

This voyage through Raja Ampat takes you into one of the world's most biodiverse marine regions, often called the "Crown Jewel of the Coral Triangle." It is home to over 75% of known coral species and more than 1,500 species of reef fish.

Throughout the journey, expect a balance of calm cruising, guided water activities, and island exploration.

Highlights include vibrant reefs, manta cleaning stations, limestone karsts, hidden lagoons, and quiet beaches. Each day offers opportunities to snorkel, dive, kayak, or simply enjoy the views above and below the surface.





GETTING THERE

The Oracle is conveniently positioned at a harbor within close reach of the airport, ensuring a smooth and efficient arrival. Guests are greeted upon landing and transferred by private vehicle to the yacht's dedicated tender for a seamless boarding experience.

Day 01

ARRIVAL IN SORONG

Your journey begins in Sorong, where our team welcomes you at the airport or your hotel. A short transfer brings you to the harbor and your floating villa.

On board, meet the crew and settle in before a safety briefing and lunch. We then begin our first crossing toward Mioskon, a calm introduction to Raja Ampat.



Day 02

MANSUAR

Located in the Dampier Strait, Mansuar is home to the renowned Cape Kri, known for its exceptional marine biodiversity.

Expect encounters with schools of barracuda, batfish, reef fish, sharks, and turtles. The area also offers calm bays ideal for snorkeling, beginner diving, paddleboarding, and kayaking.

03

WAIGEO - THE PASSAGE

Wake to birdsong before cruising to a narrow channel separating Waigeo and Gam. With shifting tidal currents, this unique waterway offers a dynamic experience each time. The area is known for its striking scenery, and early risers may join a jungle trek to spot the red bird of paradise.

04

PIAYNEMO ISLAND

Home to some of Raja Ampat's most iconic views and vibrant dive sites. Explore coral-rich spots like Melissa's Garden and Anita's Garden, then hike to the famous viewpoint overlooking turquoise lagoons and limestone islets. End the day with an optional night dive or a relaxing onboard spa treatment.

Day
05

WAYAG

Wayag's iconic limestone karsts, white sand beaches, and hidden lagoons define the beauty of Raja Ampat. Start early with a hike to Mount Pindito for panoramic views, then explore calm lagoons by kayak or paddleboard. You may spot juvenile manta rays and blacktip sharks in these rich waters. End the day with a beach BBQ before returning on board for stargazing.



Day
06

WOFOH

Two islands connected by a sandbar, surrounded by calm, crystal-clear waters ideal for kayaking and paddleboarding. Divers can explore Black Forest, known for vibrant coral and abundant marine life including bumphead parrotfish and trevally. Enjoy sunset cocktails on deck followed by a dinner under the stars.

07

BATANTA

The nutrient-rich waters of the Dampier Strait attract reef and oceanic manta rays, often seen feeding or visiting cleaning stations. There is also a chance to spot dolphins in the area. In the evening, we begin our return journey to Sorong.

08

SORONG

After breakfast, it's time to say goodbye to The Oracle and crew. Transfers to the airport or your hotel will be arranged.
